

RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING SCHOOL BUS STUDENTS

1. Students shall obtain a Bus Rider Eligibility Card from the bus driver; this card must be completed and returned to the bus driver within (5) days.
2. Students are expected to remain seated for the duration of the trip.
3. Students shall not take or handle any emergency equipment inside the bus.
4. Students shall not write upon, disfigure or destroy any part of the bus.
5. Students shall not extend any part of their body, clothing or any other articles out of the bus windows or doors.
6. Students shall never board or leave the bus through the emergency door except in emergencies.
7. Students shall not carry explosives (such as fireworks), knives, weapons or any other objects which may reasonably be considered a weapon.
8. Students shall not bring or carry any type of animals, reptiles or insects on the bus.
9. Students shall not litter the bus.
10. Students shall not be allowed to get off the bus except at home or school, unless authorized in writing by parents or legal guardian.
11. It is permissible for students to ride a bus home with another student provided they both bring a note from their parent or legal guardian. Both notes need to be signed by the teacher, principal or assistant principal and presented to the bus driver.
12. Bus students must obey all school policies, rules and regulations.
- 13. Please note the Texas Education Agency as well as Chapel Hill I.S.D. requires that all students be ready at their bus stop when the bus arrives.**
