



Dear Parents,

Our system of discipline will be measured daily. Inside of your child's take home notebook are the monthly discipline sheets. Everyday your child starts out on the color green, which indicates good behavior. If your child breaks a rule, he will then change his color to yellow, first warning. If your child breaks another rule, he will then change his color to orange, second warning, and a five minute timeout. Next is the color blue, this color change will result in a ten minute timeout from recess. If your child continues to misbehave throughout the day, he will change his color to red, final offense. This will indicate further disciplinary action, trip to the principal's office or loss of special privileges. I will write a brief description explaining the color change on the behavior page in your child's notebook.

At the end of the week, on Friday, your child will receive a "prize" from the treasure box. This is only for students who have not changed their color past orange all week.

I ask that you please initial everyday, this way I know that you are monitoring behavior with me. Thank you for your cooperation.
