Action Items – **Lamond Dean**, Superintendent of Schools, asked that the board approve the following action items at the May 13, 2019, Regular Meeting:

Canvass the Results of the May 4, 2019, CHISD School Board Election

The Chapel Hill ISD Board of Trustees is required by law to officially canvass the election results of the May 4, 2019, school board election. Motion made by **Martin Ibarra** and seconded by **Fred Elder, Jr.**, to accept the results of the May 4, 2019, School Board Election. Motion carried 7-0.

Swearing in of Newly Elected Board Members and Reorganization of the Board

*In accordance with Election Code Section 2.052, I am certifying to the Board of Trustees that the May 4, 2019, School Board Election has passed. According to Election code Section 2.053 – Action or Certification – on receipt of the Certification, the governing body of the political subdivision by order or ordinance may declare **Les Schminkey** elected to the office in Place 1, **David Acker** elected to the office in Place 2, and **Rickey Mosley** re-elected to the office in Place 3.*

Reorganization of the Board

Each year after the election, board members are sworn in and the board annually reorganizes. The offices of President, Vice-President, and Secretary need to be filled by a duly-elected school board member of the Chapel Hill ISD Board of Trustees. Motion made by **Fred Elder, Jr.**, and seconded by **Tammy Humes** to nominate **Martin Ibarra** as President. The Board voted to select **Martin Ibarra** as Board President. Motion carried 7-0. Motion made by **Rickey Mosley** and seconded by **David Acker** to nominate **Glen Elliott, Jr.**, as Vice-President. The Board voted to select **Glen Elliott, Jr.**, as Vice-President. Motion carried 7-0. Motion made by **Martin Ibarra** to have a deciding vote on two nominees (**Tammy Humes** and **Rickey Mosley**) in the Board Secretary position.

Glen Elliott, Jr., asked by a show of hands who is voting in favor of **Tammy Humes** as Board Secretary. **Tammy Humes, David Acker,** and **Les Schminkey** raised their hand in favor of **Tammy Humes**.

Glen Elliott, Jr., asked by a show of hands who is voting in favor of **Rickey Mosley** as Board Secretary. **Glen Elliott, Jr., Martin Ibarra, Fred Elder, Jr.,** and **Rickey Mosley** raised their hand in favor of **Rickey Mosley**. The Board voted to select **Rickey Mosley** as Board Secretary. Motion carried 4/3 in favor of **Rickey Mosley**.



Approval of Extending Depository Contract of an Additional Two-Year Term

Lamond Dean recommended approving a two-year extension of our Depository Contract with American State Bank. Pursuant to Article III, Section E of our Depository Contract for Funds, the school district and the depository may agree to extend the contract for a two-year term in accordance with Section 45.205 Subchapter G of the Texas Education Code. An extension under this subsection is not subject to the requirements of Section 45.206 of the Code, which requires bid notices. Motion made by **Tammy Humes** and seconded by **Rickey Mosley** to extend our current contract with American State Bank through August 31, 2021. Motion carried 7-0.
